Standardized Testing

In 2016-2017 our students scored 15% higher on the SAT than the national average on the Math and Evidence-Based Reading & Writing according to SAT data provided by The College Board. During the 2016-2017 school year, 65% of students taking ALVS AP courses scored a 3 or higher on the College Board exam, five percentage points higher than the national average of 60% for the same exams.
